The Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) is breaking ground on the construction of a new 84,403 square-foot structure at the corner of Tudor and Elmore Roads. This four-story building will house ANTHC's Division of Environmental Health and Engineering and Division of Community Health Services, which work to provide facilities and health care for Alaska Natives throughout the state. The eco-friendly building will meet LEED Silver requirements.
