Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium Leadership Transition

Garvin Federenko has been named acting Chief Executive Officer of the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC). The ANTHC Board of Directors selected Federenko to replace Don Kashevaroff, who served as ANTHC CEO for three years, Board Chairman and President Andy Teuber said in an announcement Monday morning.

Federenko has served as Senior Director of Administration and Finance at ANTHC since 1998, when he helped transition the organization from federal to tribal management.
