- 'NOS' is only used when you can not determine specifically what brand was given.

Comvax®	COMVAX (51)	Comvax® (PedvaxHib®+Hep B), not used by the State since early 2000's, may be used by other states
DTaP	DTAP,NOS (107)	DTaP not otherwise specified
DT, whole cell pertussis	DTP (1)	whole cell pertussis hasn't been used since early 90's
"H Big"	HBIG (30)	Hepatitis B Immunoglobulin
Hep A	HEP A NOS (85)	Hepatitis A not otherwise specified
Hep B	HEP B NOS (45)	Hepatitis B not otherwise specified
Hibtiter®	HIBTITER (47)	Hibtiter® has not been used in Alaska since the late 90's, may be currently used in other states
Meningo-polysaccharide	MENING-PS (32)	rarely used but found around the State
Oral polio	OPV (2)	oral polio (not used in the USA since 2000)
Polio	POLIO NOS (89)	polio vaccine not otherwise specified
