

ABC's of Patient Benefits

Apply for **Denali Kid Care** or **Family Medicaid** today!

Applications are available at your local Patient Benefits office, the local clinic or Fee Agent.

Be prepared. Be sure to have a copy of your last 30 days paystubs/income with your application and a copy of your most recent bank statement if applicable.

Coverage includes: Dr. visits, Checkups & Screenings, Vision, Dental, Hearing, Substance Abuse Treatment, Lab Tests, Speech & Physical Therapy, Hospitalization, Children's Chiropractic, Children's Foot Dr., Mental health, Prescriptions, Pre-existing Condition Coverage and more.

Denali KidCare provides health coverage for children and teens under age 19 and for pregnant women who meet income and other eligibility requirements.

Even if you have other health insurance, you or your children may still be eligible.

Fill out application completely, sign and date.

Go to your local Patient Benefits office or Fee Agent.

How long will it take? It may take up to 30 days to process your application.

Interview is required on Family or Elder Medicaid applications to determine if you are eligible for assistance. Your application will be denied if you do not attend an interview within 30 days.

Just remember, a standard deduction may apply for expenses related to employment and day care expenses.

Know your eligibility end dates.

List all members of the household.

Medicaid offers medical coverage to families, children, elderly, disabled adults, and pregnant women. Also helps with Medicare Parts A and B premiums.

Never forget to send in your renewals.

Open vouchers and bring to local clinic or hospital during visits.

Provide proof of pregnancy from your health care provider if you or someone in your household is pregnant, also provide proof of medical or health insurance, including a copy of the Medicare Card, if you have any.

Questions are welcome.

Read the "Rights and Responsibilities" and sign the application.

Send in renewals in a timely manner so there won't be a lapse in coverage.

Taxi vouchers/lodging are available with Denali KidCare/Medicaid travel.

Understand your coverage.

Verify Documents. I.D. & Birth Certificates must be verified with a green sticker by a local Fee Agent or your Patient Benefits Specialist.

Xerox copy your application, paystubs, verified documents, etc., mail original and keep a copy.

You must report changes: New residence or someone moves into or out of your home, household gets a vehicle, Cash/bank account is \$2,000 or more, change in unearned income, employment changes, change in child support you pay, change in health insurance, change in pregnancy status. This must be done within 10 days.
