This is the month the client will have to renew

These three lines together show the client was approved for Medicaid in Nov 09 and has been receiving benefits monthly since then. Looking at the beginning date and end dates you can see each month is covered. When you see a client that has multiple entries like this you will have to look at the beginning and ending dates for each line to see the covered months.

This is the month the case is currently in (usually the month after the report was run). If the current month is not correct, the client's renewal is due or the case is not rolling correctly and DPA should be contacted.
