

National Data Warehouse (NDW) Workload Update

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A Quick Look at Last Year...

▶ FY10 Facts & Successes:

- 1,558,429 APC visits exported for Alaska; 2% increase over FY09
 - 196 facilities from 23 THOs exported APC
 - 136 facilities from 15 THOs exported Dental
 - 3 new sites began exporting to NDW
- ▶ As always, a big thank you for your diligent work to ensure timely submission of your registration and encounter files

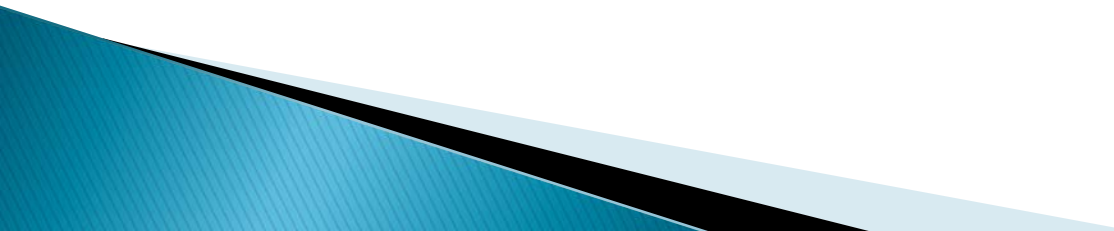
APC Workload Update as of March 11, 2011

- ▶ Total APC workload encounters submitted for Alaska thus far, FY11: 488,160

NDW Report Dates for FY11

- ▶ Upcoming report dates for FY11:
 - **April 15**, for data received in the proper format by **April 7**
 - **May 13**, for data received in the proper format by **May 5**
 - **June 10**, for data received in the proper format by **June 2**

NDW Report Dates for FY11 (cont'd)

- **July 15**, for data received in the proper format by **July 7**
 - **August 12**, for data received in the proper format by **August 4**
 - **September 9**, for data received in the proper format by **September 1**
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NDW Report Dates for FY11 (cont'd)

- **October**: Weekly reports will be run for data received in the proper format by 8 days prior to report release date

FY 11 DEADLINE for Submission

- ▶ DROP-DEAD date for FY11 workload & registration files submission is **October 27, 2011!**
- ▶ As we all know, this date always approaches faster than we expect, so the time to act on issues/concerns is...you guessed it...ASAP!


What You Can Expect from Me...

- ▶ I will send your monthly APC workload reports for your review (please request to be added to your organization's list of recipients if you are not already on it)
 - ▶ I will review your numbers throughout the year and let you know if I see areas we may want to look at further
 - ▶ I will provide additional information about the NDW and workload that you have, per your request
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What You Can Expect from Me... (cont'd)

- ▶ I will answer any other questions you may have
- ▶ Most importantly, I am here to support you! Please contact me anytime you have questions, concerns or requests for information and I will be happy to assist you in any way that I can.

What I Recommend You Do...

- ▶ Review the monthly workload reports sent to staff at your facilities; contact me with any questions or concerns as soon as possible
 - ▶ Ask yourself this: Do you believe that the NDW workload numbers I send for your facilities reflects your *true* workload counts? If not, contact me ASAP and we will research the situation. There are a number of factors that could explain the inconsistency, and fixes could be applied.
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What I Recommend You Do... (cont'd)

- ▶ Let me know if there are other staff in your organization who you feel could benefit from the information I send, and I will add them to my distribution lists
