# ANTHC Divisions

- Community Health Services

- 230 individuals trained on Suicide intervention skills
- 16 Emergency and Pandemic flu preparedness trainings
- \$800,000 funds per year to increase Colorectal Cancer screening.

- First 4 Dental Health Aide Therapists graduated in the United States
- CDC grant secured to study chronic Hepatitis B and C and vaccine protection in infants

# Community Health Services



- Alaska Rural Utility Collaborative
  - 17 Communities participating
- Construction Skills Training Program
  - 19 community members received Commercial Drivers License training
  - 37 community members received Carpentry and Plumbing training
  - 174 community members received Water and Sewer Operations training

# Environmental Health and Engineering



- 45 projects completed in 35 communities
  - 6 clinics constructed and 2 clinic designed
- \$114 million awarded for future sanitation planning, design, study and construction projects

# Environmental Health and Engineering



- Joint Commission Accreditation: Top 5% in the country
- Magnet Recertification
  - Only Magnet Facility in Alaska
  - Only 5% of hospitals in the country are designated
- Electronic Health Record Planning

# Alaska Native Medical Center



- Expansion of the Cancer Program
- Increased Specialty Physicians
- Expansion of Services due to ARRA Funds
  - Internal Medicine
  - Emergency Department
  - Oncology Clinic
  - Labor and Delivery
  - 64 slice CT Scan

# Alaska Native Medical Center



- 55 graduates of the Community Health Aide Program
- 100 digital Telehealth stethoscopes deployed to rural health clinics
- 157 doctors and 482 Magnet® nurses
- 1,548 babies delivered
- 1,953 total employees
- 6,641 inpatient admissions
- 11,794 surgeries and endoscopies
- 52,600 emergency room visits, 5,632 of which were Level II trauma cases
- 404,000 outpatient visits
