Jacquii Lambert



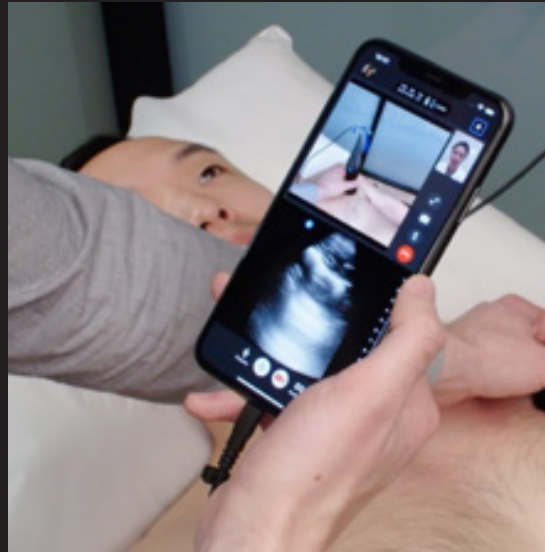

She is the publisher of The Archive by Native Time, a media collaborative project that develops authentic and contemporary Indigenous productions in print, audio and video format. Jacquii uses her digital platform to create dialogue around culture and wellness through poetry, storytelling, and visual art. Above all else, Jacquii is an auntie to nearly 30 kids ranging from infancy to adulthood.

Fund-a-need Spotlight

Each year, the Foundation raises funds for a special initiative. This year's Fund-a-Need will support three important areas:

Cardiology Care, Close to Home

Echocardiography, the imaging of the heart's structures and function, is one of the most important tools available for the diagnosis and management of cardiovascular disease. Thousands of Alaskans are forced to travel from their homes to where the equipment and sonographer are to receive an echocardiogram. The Butterfly iQ+ (Human) can easily plug into a smartphone and be used to provide detailed ultrasound imaging used for echocardiograms. Funds raised will support the purchase and deployment of multiple Butterfly IQ devices in clinics and hospitals across the state of Alaska so patients can receive specialized care, right when they need it the most.



COVID-19 Patient Support

Funds raised as part of this effort will provide direct support to COVID-19 patients within the Alaska Tribal Health System.

Privacy for Emergent Patients

Noise reduction has been shown to increase patient healing, staff effectiveness and the patient's confidence in the medical staff. HUSH curtains, also known as noise deafening curtains, add an "absorptive surface area" to each Alaska Native Medical Center (ANMC) Emergency Department bay where they soften the noise level and muffle surrounding sounds. Funds raised will support the purchase and installation of curtains at ANMC.
